Machame Route Kilimanjaro climbing, + safari Serengeti, National Park

NO OF DAYS—13 Days

NO OF PAX----- 3 Adult.

TYPE OF SAFARI- private Climbing

Day1:

Pickup from the Airport *

Pick up from the Airport then transfer to the hotel, you will find your safari guide waiting at the airport then you will drive to the moshi town for Dinner and Overnight:

Overnight on full board: Weru Weru River Lodge



DAY 2

Weru Weru River + Machame Hut

A guide and a mountain support crew will arrive at the hotel in the morning in order to meet you and hold another short briefing, after which you will travel by vehicle (roughly 1hour) to Kilimanjaro National Park's southern entrance: Machame Gate (1800 m). After the quick formality of acquiring climbing permits and registering with the search and rescue service, the

group will start trekking towards the first camp of the route: Machame Camp (3000 m). Raincoats are necessary on this day in particular, as you will be walking through rainforest. By the time you reach the camp, our professional mountain crew will prepare everything necessary, put tents and cook dinner for you.

Overnight on full board: Machame hut public Camp



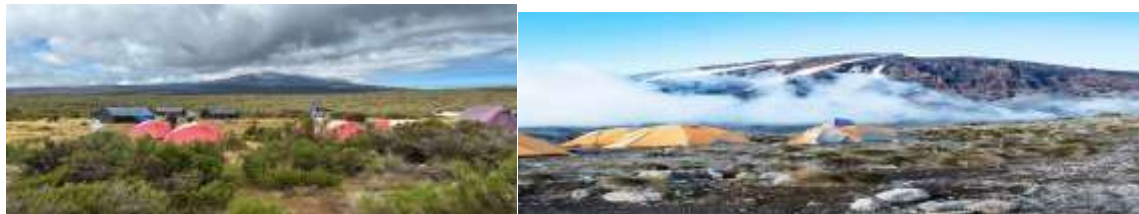
DAY 3 **Machame Hut to Shira Caves**

An early wakeup, breakfast, and a gradual trek upwards until 3,800 meters; at that point for the first time you will be able to see stunning views of Shira Plateau and Kibo Volcano.

On the whole, the passage from Machame Camp to the second high-altitude Shira cave camp(3,800m) it takes about 4-5 hours. This will allow you to start the acclimatization process gradually, which is a mainstay of good trekking. When you reach the camp, your team of specialists will cook you lunch and you will have the chance to rest in your tent or walk around the nearby area.

Overnight on full board: Shira Caves public Camp

DAY 4 **Shira Caves To Baranco**

After breakfast you will leave Shira cave Camp (3,800 m) and start your way to the key point of the route: Lava Tower (4,630 m). This section of the route has a lot of ascents and descents that end in a camp at over 4,600 meters. You may feel some discomfort, but in order to successfully acclimate to the altitude you have to spend at least 1 hours here, so this is where lunch will be.

Then you will descend to Barranco Camp (3,960 m). Here you can see the famous Barranco Wall, impressive in both its massive size and steepness! Next day you will be climbing it, but don't worry: it features a very simple hiking trail.

Overnight on full board: Baranco public Camp



DAY 5

Baranco to Karanga

Early wakeup, breakfast and the start of summing Barranco Wall (we recommend you leave the camp as early as possible to avoid crowds of the other groups). Hiking up the gorge wall is not difficult and only takes around an hour and a half. After the climb you can have a rest and take photos in front of the Kibo volcano.

Then you start a hike to Barafu Camp, which features numerous ascents and descents during the route, but don't worry: our guides are experts at choosing an optimal pace for the group. On way you will be offered lunch. After lunch you will be heading to Barafu Camp, early dinner and early Bed.

Overnight on full board: Karanga public Camp

DAY 6:

KARANGA CAMP TO BARAFU CAMP

In the morning after breakfast you begin your way to Barafu Summit Camp (4,640 m), the starting point for a night summing Uhuru Peak (5,895 m). Our team will set up a camp for you ahead of time, including tents and sleeping bags, so you can relax. After regaining strength, you have to complete an acclimatization hike towards the intermediate Kosovo Summit Camp (4,800 m) and then back to Barafu Camp, where you will be served a hot dinner. It is better to spend the remainder of the day resting and sleeping before night summing.

Overnight on full board: Barafu public Camp

DAY 7:

BARAFU CAMP TO UHURU PEAK, DOWN TO BARAFU, THEN MWEKA CAMP

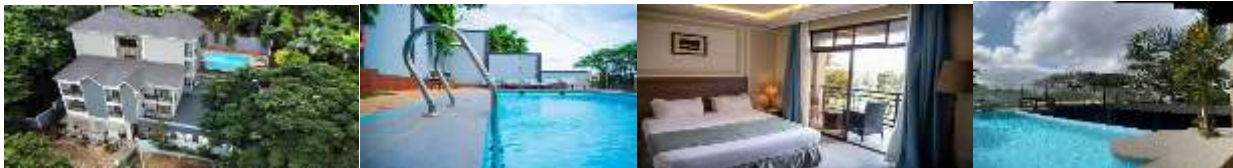
Departure from Barafu Camp (4,640 m) at night and the start of summing Kilimanjaro: Uhuru Peak (5,895 m). Technically the climb is relatively simple; however, the most challenging part is the high altitude. Each pair of climbers will get a personal guide for the entire ascent to monitor your physical and mental conditions. After your successful ascent to Uhuru Peak - the top of Mount Kilimanjaro and the last point of the climb on the Machame Route, you can descend to the nearest glacier if desired. Then you will return to Barafu Camp and after a 2-hour rest continue your descent to Millennium Camp 3995 or Mweka Camp (3,100 m).

Overnight on full board: Mweka public Camp

DAY 8 Mweka to Greenside hotel --Arusha

The camp is situated in a tropical rainforest. When you wake up, you will feel relief from the reduction of the height and the satisfaction of reaching the summit. After a warm breakfast, you will head for the park's exit: Mweka Gate (1,650 m). After your descent the whole group will gather to congratulate you, having lunch and drinks followed by offering you a chance to share your opinions on the climb. Lastly, we will present you with your commemorative certificates and provide you a transfer to Arusha for dinner and overnight

Day 9: Leisure Day in Arusha – City Tour

After breakfast at your hotel, enjoy a relaxing morning at your own pace. Later, embark on a guided Arusha City Tour to experience the city's rich culture and history. Visit the local markets, the Maasai Market, the Cultural Heritage Centre, and other points of interest while learning about the daily life and traditions of the local community. After enjoy the day in arusha town you will drive back to your hotel for dinner and Overnight.

Overnight on full board: Greenside hotel Arusha



Day 10: Fly from Arusha to Kogatende – Northern Serengeti

After breakfast, transfer to Arusha Airport for your scheduled flight to Kogatende Airstrip in the Northern Serengeti. Upon arrival, you will be welcomed by your professional safari guide and begin your first game drive en route to your camp.

Spend the afternoon exploring the Mara River area, famous for the Great Wildebeest Migration (seasonal), large prides of lions, elephants, giraffes, zebras, and other wildlife. Enjoy a spectacular sunset before returning to camp.

Overnight on full board: Kogatende Clasic View Camp/ Sero Migration Tented CAMP



Day 11: Full-Day Game Drive in Northern Serengeti

Enjoy an early breakfast before departing for a full-day game drive in the Northern Serengeti. This region is renowned for its abundant wildlife and, from approximately July to October, offers the opportunity to witness the dramatic Mara River crossings during the Great Migration. Throughout the day, search for lions, leopards, cheetahs, elephants, buffaloes, and numerous plains game while taking in the breathtaking landscapes.

Return to your camp in the evening for dinner and an overnight stay.

Day 12: Northern Serengeti to Central Serengeti

After breakfast, enjoy a scenic game drive as you travel south toward the Central Serengeti (Seronera). Along the way, continue searching for wildlife while passing through the endless plains of the Serengeti. Arrive in the central region in time for an afternoon game drive, where you may encounter lions, leopards, hyenas, hippos, and a variety of antelope species.

Dinner and overnight at your selected camp in Central Serengeti.

Overnight on full board: Friends Tented Camp/ Osero Serengeti Tented Camp



Day 13: Morning Game Drive – Fly Back to Arusha

Start the day with an early morning game drive, the best time to observe predators returning from their night hunt and other wildlife becoming active. After breakfast, transfer to Seronera Airstrip for your scheduled flight back to Arusha,

- Full board accommodation + authentic local meals in the afternoon (no lunch boxes).

- Concession fees in Serengeti.
- Professional English and French-speaking guide.
- All beverages offered by your guide during the safari.
- Sunset aperitif in the heart of nature.
- Drinks, fresh water, coffee, and tea during the safari.
- All transfers.
- Flight to Kogatende Serengeti and back to arusha

This price does not include:

- International flights.
- Personal expenses.
- Tips at the end of your safari. (In Tanzania, it is customary to give a tip if you appreciated the service provided, around \$15 per person per day for the guide).

- -3 Meals every day on Kilimanjaro

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Climbing Excludes in the Price;

- -Air tickets;
- -Visa fee;
- -Personal equipment {wearing, shoes etc}

- -Tips to your guides, cooks, porters (per day per person)

What to pack:

- Lightweight but preferably long clothing to protect against insect bites. Avoid white (it gets dirty), bright colors, and black and blue (which attract tsetse flies).
- A sweater or sweatshirt for evenings, which can be cool.
- Binoculars; you will have a pair in the vehicle, but it's okay to bring your own if you wish.

Vehicle (4x4, Toyota Land Cruiser):

Transport in a 4x4 during the safari. The vehicle is equipped with a retractable roof that protects from the sun and offers a 360-degree view for optimal wildlife observation and photography.

Visa, Health, and Insurance:

It is your responsibility to have all necessary travel documents required for your itinerary, as well as all health certificates and others that may be needed.

Upon request, we can provide more information or contacts for further details on these matters.

Before your departure, you are required to obtain specific vaccinations for your visit to East Africa, as requirements may change from time to time.

Booking:

To book, you must pay a deposit of 30%, and the remaining payment can be made before the safari via bank transfer or in cash upon arrival. All payments must be completed before the safari! Card payments are accepted but incur a 4% fee.

Flexibility:

While we will do our best to ensure you travel as comfortable as possible and adhere closely to the planned itinerary, you are expected to be flexible and open-minded regarding delays or last-minute changes to the itinerary.
